During your Lapland De Luxe stay in Olos you will get familiarized with the Lapp nature and the way of life through amazing adventures on snowmobiles, on IceKart track and on dog-sledges. You will also get to meet Lapp Shaman, visit Sweden and do a reindeer speed race! Welcome to experience the Fells Region of Lapland!

Departure & transfer to airport



Day 1 - Arctic Ice Bar

Upon arrival to Kittilä airport meet & greet by Lapland Safaris guide and board the waiting coach for transfer to Lapland Hotel Olos in Muonio.

Welcoming dinner is served in the evening in the Polar Kota restaurant. The dinner begins at restaurant terrace, lightened with the magnificent lumberjack log fires. At terrace person dressed in a traditional Sámi dress hands out reindeer bells as gifts for each guest and the welcoming drinks are served from the Arctic Ice Bar, bar made of ice! Inside the restaurant the dinner begins with Lapp Joiku singing performance.

Day 2 - Snowy race, Swedish safari

Finnish buffet breakfast is served in the hotel restaurant. Shortly after breakfast meet your guide at the hotel reception and short walk to the clothing area for delivery of warm safari clothing. Snowmobiles are waiting for you and after safety and driving instructions it is time for a snowmobile safari. The safari heads for the snowy forests and ice-covered lakes, and whether conditions permitting, a visit is made to the top of the Olos fell. From the top of the fell opens beautiful scenery over the Pallas-Ylläs National Park.





The safari gets some extra speed, for you will make a stop at the IceKart track. IceKart is exciting and truly fun go-cart race on ice. There is a training period and final race just like in the Formula races. Skill and composure are the keys here. Icekart is the experience!



After the race the safari continues and you even get to cross the most peaceful border in the world and visit Sweden. En route a delicious soup lunch is enjoyed by campfire. Safari ends at Olos where the guide takes you to the Snow Theater to see a movie about the Northern Lights and to enjoy a warm drink.

Tonight you will enjoy the rich buffet dinner in the hotel's log-restaurant.

After the dinner some local handicraft makers arrive to the restaurant. It is time to make your own souvenir. After the short instruction everyone gets to try their hand in making a traditional Lapp handicraft with tiuhta. With tiuhta you can make a beautiful "pirtanauha" ribbon that can be used for example as a belt.

Day 3 - Animalia morning - Finnish evening

Finnish buffet breakfast is served in the hotel restaurant. In the forenoon you will get to visit a reindeer farm, coach transfer there takes approx. 10 minutes. Everyone can manage to get the reindeer driving license after short instructions. The bravest ones can then participate in the reindeer speed race, where you will drive on a 200 meters long track with three reindeers on the track at a time. The drivers are on skis behind the reindeer holding the reins. After the exiting and speedy race, soup lunch is served at the reindeer farm at a spacious, wooden kota tepee.



In the afternoon you are taken on a sled-dog safari. The route goes over the wide Lake Jerisjärvi. On the lake you will meet the Lapp Shaman who is fishing with under-ice nets... After the Shamans fishing surprice the journey continues to Äijin Pirtti cottage. The farewell dinner served in Äijin Pirtti cottage with live Finnish accordeon music. After the dinner coach transfer back to the hotel.

Day 4 - Snow Olympics and Farewells to Lapland

Finnish buffet breakfast is served in the hotel restaurant. After the breakfast there is still time to put your Lapp skills on test. Snow Olympics feature events like tandem skiing, kick sledging and throwing the Lapp lasso “suopunki”. At the end the winners will be awarded, the clothing is returned and a buffet lunch is enjoyed.

Program Inclusions:

- 3 nights' occupancy, hotel sauna and buffet breakfast in Lapland Hotel Olos, twin basis

- Day 01: Transfer by private coach from KTT airport to Lapland Hotel Olos, Arctic Ice Bar, welcoming ceremony and dinner incl. bar made of ice, lumberjack log fires, guide dressed in Sámi dress, reindeer bells, Lapp Joiku performance, three-course meal.
- Day 02: Snowy race, Swedish safari, ice-cart driving incl. equipment; snowmobile safari to Sweden incl. 2 people/snowmobile, soup lunch, Northern Lights movie at Snow Theater, warm drink. Dinner at the hotel restaurant incl. Tiuhta handicraft program.
- Day 03: Animalia morning – Finnish evening, visit to reindeer farm incl. private coach, reindeer driving license, reindeer speed race, lunch in kota; sled-dog safari to Äijin Pirtti incl. 2 people/sled, Lapp Shaman fishing surprise; farewell dinner at Äijin Pirtti incl. Finnish accordion player, three-course meal and private coach.
- Day 04: Snow Olympics incl. tandem skiing, kick sledging, suopunki throwing, hot berry juice; buffet lunch at hotel. Transfer by private coach from hotel to KTT airport.
- Safari outfits at guest's disposal during the programs: thermal overalls, boots, woollen socks, mittens, balaclavas, scarves and caps as well as helmets for snowmobiling.
- Local guiding in English during the programs
- All service fees and Value Added Tax (VAT)

Please note: *At Äijin Pirtti menu includes bread and butter as well as tap water and berry juice as drinks. Bottled water and soft drinks invoiced according to consumption. Wine, beer and other alcoholic drinks can be delivered according to subscription, invoicing according to Alko pricelist plus delivery fee 50,- €/order. Returned drinks will be charged 20 % of the Alko list price.*



GOOD TO NOTE!

All programs are with weather permittance. All the items are subject to availability at the time you request the space. We reserve the right to change the rates in the event of increase of taxes, fuel costs or similar beyond our control.

INSURANCE

All the snowmobiles and forest scooters are insured as required by the Finnish Traffic Insurance Act. This insurance covers medical care for injuries to the driver and the passenger arising from accidents. Personal injuries and damages to other parties while driving a snowmobile or forest scooter are fully covered according to the Finnish Traffic Insurance Act. Lapland Safaris is not liable in general for personal injuries or material damage arising from accidents during other games and activities such as husky sleigh safaris, reindeer safaris or other excursions in which snowmobiles or quad bikes are not involved. Personal travel insurance is therefore highly recommended.

SELF LIABILITY

Safari participants are held liable for damages caused to snowmobiles or forest scooters. Each vehicle driver must put down a damage deposit on the spot upon their arrival, by cash or credit card, if other arrangements have not been made in advance. The amount of the deposit is EUR 505,- for snowmobiles and forest scooters and EUR 841,- for jeeps. The customer must notify Lapland Safaris in advance about who (each participant individually or the orderer or company) is going to be held responsible for self liability. The self liability is mentioned during the snowmobile driving lesson before safari.

DRIVING TERMS

The driver of a snowmobile must be 15 years old with a valid driving licence, forest scooter driver has to be at least 18 years old with a valid driving license. Children under 2 years old are free of charge and children under 15 years old get a discount and they are then allowed to sit on a sledge pulled by a snowmobile. Children under 15 years old are seated in a sledge pulled by snowmobile and are given helmets.



Driving a snowmobile or forest scooter under the influence of alcohol or any narcotic products is prohibited by Finnish law. As the responsible safari organizers, we reserve the right to change the routing and duration of the excursions if necessary, according to the prevailing weather and snow conditions, or if deemed advisable for the sake of safety and the comfort of the participants. We also reserve the right to discontinue the safari if a participant is seen as a potential danger to him/herself or to others, or is in poor health.

MEALS & BEVERAGES

All lunches in the program include 2 courses, bread & spread, and as beverages water, berry juice and coffee/tea. All dinners in the program include 3 courses, bread & spread, and as beverages water and coffee/tea.

TRANSFERS

Transfers are organized by private coach. One coach has capacity for maximum of 49 persons in the group. When more than 49 persons in the group transfer costs need to be revised accordingly: 50 – 98 pax → 2 coaches and double rate for transfer; 99 – 147 pax → 3 coaches and triple rate for transfer; etc.
