



### PALLAS - FELL PARADISE

Pallas is a place for cross-country skiing, downhill skiing, and hiking in amazing national scenery under the guidance of the most traditional skiing school in Finland. The skiing school of Pallaksen Pöllöt combines cross-country skiing, fell trips, downhill skiing, and the activities of the ski centre. As a customer, you can influence the planning of the weekly programme, and the Pöllös will take you to places you might not find by yourself in the vast national park.

### AT PALLAS, YOU NEVER HAVE TO SKI ALONE

The destination of the daily trips of Pöllöt is usually the fell if the weather permits, but the trips can also take us to the snowy forests, if that is the customer's wish. 3, 5, and 10-kilometre routes, a children's track, and a snowshoe track can all be found in the vicinity of the hotel. With the Olos/Pallas pass you can ski down both fells and both in Luosto and Ounasvaara. Six-day tickets and above as well as seasonal tickets grant you one day of skiing at Ylläs. The SuperSkiPass has unlimited access to Ylläs, Olos, Pallas, and Levi.

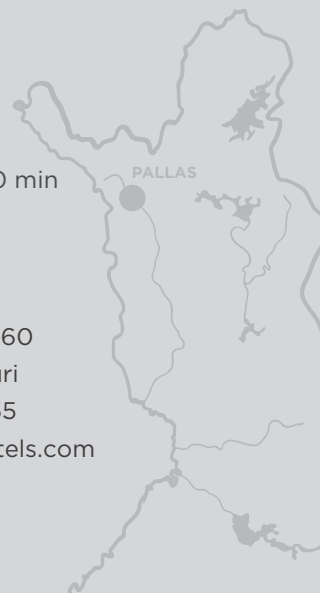
